Appreciating Our Differences: We often use the word tolerance in the context of discussing racial, religious, or cultural differences. In our families and in our neighborhoods, our tolerance, or intolerance, of human diversity is revealed in the way we treat people who are different from us: both in the way we interact with them directly, and what we say about them when they're not around. Our children notice even the most, subtle of innuendos, and while they may not understand the full implication of our words, they pick up our attitudes and mimic our behavior. Our children are growing up in a world where getting along with our global neighbors and sharing the environment, commercial trade, and a planetary fate will be inescapable facts of life. Our kids will need to be comfortable with people of different colors, cultures, abilities, and beliefs.
